Format:

- 1) 4-team pools play 3 games to 25; 5-team pools play 2 games to 25.
- 2) Warm-ups for the first match of the day shall start at 8:15am sharp;
- 3) Warm-ups shall be 2-4-4 for the first match of the day;
- 4) Warm-ups shall be 1-2-2 for all other matches. No shared hitting.
- 5) Work Teams MUST provide 1 Score Keeper, 1 Flipper, 1 Libero Tracker/Assistant Score Keeper, 2 Line Judges, and a 2nd Referee.

Directions:

From the North (Lansdale, PA): Route 363 South and Make RIGHT onto Route 63 (Sumneytown Road). Pass PA Turnpike interchange and make LEFT onto Forty Foot Road and Follow to Route 73 West (Skippack Pike). At traffic signal, make Right and continue to Route 113 traffic signal and and make LEFT onto Route 113 South. Continue to traffic signal at Route 29 and make RIGHT onto Route 29 North. Travel 1/2 mile and make LEFT into Perkiomen Valley High School.

From South (West Chester, PA): Route 202 North to Route 422 West to the Collegeville/Phoenixville and Route 29 Exit. Follow Route 29 NORTH through several traffic signals and a few miles into Collegeville. At "T" intersection, make a RIGHT turn and quick LEFT turn and follow the Route 29 NORTH signs. Continue for a few miles and cross over route 113. Travel 1/2 mile and make a LEFT turn into Perkiomen Valley High School.

From the East (King of Prussia, PA): Route 422 West to the Collegeville/Phoenixville and Route 29 Exit. Follow Route 29 NORTH through several traffic signals and a few miles into Collegeville. At "T" intersection, make a RIGHT turn and quick LEFT turn and follow the Route 29 NORTH signs. Continue for a few miles and cross over route 113. Travel 1/2 mile and make a LEFT turn into Perkiomen Valley High School.

From the West (Reading, PA): Route 422 East to Royersford Exit. Make LEFT onto Township Line Road. Pass through 5 traffic signals and Ridge Pike. Make RIGHT onto Wartman Road and travel 8/10 of a mile and make RIGHT onto Kagey Road. Go to first stop sign and make LEFT onto Campus Drive. Pass Evergreen Elementary School on right and Middle School-East on the left. The high school will be on the right.

From the Northwest (Quakertown, PA): From Route 309 or the Turnpike-Northeast extension, follow Route 663 SOUTH to Route 29. Make LEFT onto Route 29 SOUTH. Continue on 29 SOUTH through Schwenksville. Continue a few more miles to Perkiomen Valley High School on the right.

Facilities:

- 1) Doors Open at 7:45am.
- 2) Girl's locker room and designated areas will be made available for team gear, equipment, personal items, etc.
- 3) Teams will NOT be allowed to loiter or store items outside designated areas.
- 4) Concession stand and dining area will be open and available.
- 5) Only rubber tipped chairs will be allowed on gymnasium floors.
- 6) ABSOLUTELY NO food or drinks in gymnasiums.
- 7) ONLY water in closed plastic containers are allowed in gymnasiums.

ECV, KRVA and PVHS are not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged items.

Playoffs:

Playoff Bracket - Top 2 teams from each pool based on total wins advance to the Playoff Bracket. Ties will be resolved based on the current KRVA Junior Operating Code. Six total teams will advance to playoffs.

Second-in-pool teams will be moved to avoid same-pool match ups in accordance with the op code.

Quarter-final matches are 1 game to 25pts and will be played on the courts of the respective 1st seeds. Semi-finals and Finals matches are best of 3 games (25,25,15) if time permits.

Work Teams - Quarter finals

The 4 losing teams from the last pool-play match in each pool will work these 4 matches. If one of these teams is in the playoffs, the winner of that last game must stay and work.

Work Teams - Semi-finals

The 2 losing teams in the quarters with the least to travel will work the 2 semi-final matches. Semis to be played on courts #1 and #3.

Work Team - Finals

Of the 2 losing Semi-finals teams, the 1 with the least to travel must stay to work the Finals. Finals to be played on center court (court#2).
